



Cancer documentary to be shown on KAKM

At age 48, Pulitzer Prize-winning photojournalist John Kaplan was diagnosed with lymphoma. As a result, the photographer decided to turn the camera on himself and document his fight against cancer.

That footage became the video chronicle "Not as I Pictured," which has been airing on PBS affiliates across the country and aired on KAKM, Channel 7 this past Thursday. You can catch it again at 6 p.m. Sunday.
